To the EUSEM members,

Dear EUSEM members, I'am applying to the election as Treasurer in the EUSEM board of directors. I am attaching a short CV and presenting below my experience.

My name is Said LARIBI, I am 49 years old, married with 4 kids. I am a senior emergency physician. I worked 11 years in APHP, the university hospital of Paris and then joined the city of Tours where I was recruited as full professor of Emergency Medicine and chair of the Emergency Medicine Department at the University hospital since 2015. Our ED receives 52 000 patients per year and 214 000 calls to the county emergency dispatch center (SAMU). My team is composed of 40 emergency physicians plus two assistant professors.

I am fluent in English, and regularly invited to international congresses and research seminars.

Member of the EUSEM since many years, I joined the Research Committee (RC) when it was created by the EUSEM board of directors in 2011. I then became chair of this RC from 2015 to 2018. During these years and despite the lack of funding, we managed to do an international study (EuroDEM) that recruited more than 2500 patients over 66 EDs in Europe and is now published.

My position as chair of the RC ended in 2018. We have in the Research Committee talented members that took over this charge since 2018, namely Mehmet Karamercan and Martin Möckel.

I was asked by the board of directors and by the EUSEM research committee to become chair of the EUSEM research network since 2019. I'am pleased to announce that this network has been able in a very short time to settle a European study on Covid-19 this year with preliminary results hopefully presented at our virtual congress next September.

I would like to thank our President, Luis Garcia-Castrillo and our vice-president, Christoph Dodt for nominating me to the Treasurer election. You can count on me, if I'am elected to continue my investment in the life of our scientific society.
